RE: DISTRIBUTION REPORT FOR GOODS IN KIND

1.0 Introduction

I wish to extend sincere thanks to Mission World Aid Inc. for the tremendous work done in support of the needy people and institutions in our community in Uganda.

The goods donated were received properly and all in good condition. The container was transported to a safer place in Kampala by rail transport from Mombasa port. After offloading, they were grouped according to churches, schools and health units that were to receive them with the help of the distribution committee of 5 pastors.

The churches, schools and health units that received goods are at distant places from Kampala, Kiboga, Mubende and Mityana Districts. They were distributed by use of a vehicle to deliver them to individual destination places (churches, schools and health units).

The recipients were very glad when they received the goods and were fighting for them with a lot of yearning as the goods were fewer than the number of people demanding for them. This is an indicator of great need in our rural community.

3.0 Challenges:

- ✚ The overwhelming demand from the rural beneficiary needy families posed difficulties in the distribution exercise as they were fighting for the goods (clothes, shoes, and household items)
- ✚ Transportation of goods from Kampala to rural villages was really expensive as some beneficiary communities could not contribute towards the costs.

The demand from the rural communities for summer clothes, shoes, beddings and household items is still high. Also school equipment and furniture are still challenging the school in that they find it difficult to offer quality education as their counterparts in urban settings.

I would, therefore, humbly request for another container/containers to be organized and delivered to our needy communities, schools and health units.
