## **From the Director**

**D**ear Friends,

Since our previous newsletter several events have occurred that I would like to share with you.

Early in March Anthony Moore (Deputy Director of House of Prayer), Cynthia Lothian and I attended the Joseph Company Prophetic Summit in Canberra for market place people. Today there is a stirring and a new hunger for God in the market place and the calling forth of Nehemiahs to pray over cities. The speakers were Bob Fraser who is Director of the Joseph Company at the International House of Prayer in Kansas City, and Bob Hartley who is also part of the team, and is a pastor and former missionary who now runs his own business in Kansas City.

Bob Hartley prophesied over many people including Anthony Moore and myself. This greatly encouraged us! The word to me was extensive and confirmed God's call to raise up prayer teams and extend the hand of mercy towards the poor which I saw as being outworked in our Mission World Aid calling.

We met many people from the business world whom God is raising up across the nation.

## **Commonwealth Games**

Later in March Brian and I were in Melbourne and attended two nights of the athletics at the Commonwealth Games. We saw the fastest man in the world running, Jamaican Asafa Powell. I thought of Elijah running in supernatural divine power before the chariot of Ahab. How fast has God created man to run, jump, hurdle, throw the discus or swim? Powell is a committed Christian who honoured God in all his press interviews.

It was a British pastor, Reverend Ashley, who gave shape to the Commonwealth Games thirty-nine years after it was first mooted in 1891. According to a report in The Age, his dream crystallised in 1930 at Hamilton in Canada. Several of the athletes that we saw honoured God in their victories.

A few years ago a prayer leader of international standing said to me, "If nations don't play sport they are tempted to express themselves through war".

May God continue to raise up men and women who will compete to the glory of His Name.

## **Prayernet SA**

On Wednesday August 3<sup>rd</sup> last year I was seeking the Lord for future direction following the decision to lay down the Pray SA Intercessors' meetings that I had run for eight years. I was actually wondering if the Lord wanted me to step down from the prayer movement in our State. On that day however, I was given a clear vision by the Lord. I saw Jesus throwing a fishing net over all of South Australia and the words Prayernet SA came to me. I saw each little square of the net as a prayer cell and gained the impression that it was a fishing net because God was raising up praying people to pray in a harvest of souls. This net that Jesus was throwing was preparing the way for a fresh wave of evangelism.

A few months later Pastor Phyllis Lines, who is being used by God to help raise up prayer groups in country regions, shared with me a similar vision that an intercessor had received. In that vision the net was red which is evidently the sort of net used for fresh water fishing!

We are now launching Prayernet SA at a two day seminar at Hahndorf Resort on 16-17 June. We are privileged to have as our guest speaker Pastor Anne Edgar from Victory Life Centre in Perth, where Pastor Margaret Court is senior pastor. Anne is an experienced intercessor and anointed teacher. Enclosed is a brochure for registration. Chris Hagger will lead the worship. Chris has just released his new CD "Dancing with Jesus".

Prayernet SA will be part of the ministry of House of Prayer and Pastor Phyllis Lines and I will share the role of prayer co-ordinators, networking the prayer groups and strengthening them through seminars, website teaching, and other resources.

Prayernet SA will be affiliated with the Australian Prayer Network.

Please uphold us in prayer as we obey the Lord in this new challenge. There is a spirit of apathy and lukewarmness, even within the church, that is tempting us to not press in in prayer to discern God's redemptive calling on our State.

## **Prayer Teams**

One of our assignments here at House of Prayer is to help mobilize prayer teams to go out on specific assignments to pray. Because of the sensitivity involved I have, up to now, not reported any of this in our newsletters.

I feel, however, to write about the prayer battle that is going on against drug trafficking in this nation. Two years ago I was staying overnight at a motel near Sydney airport enroute to returning home from a trip. Early on the morning of departure I went for a walk and found myself near the cargo area of one of our major airlines. There was spiritually a dark oppression in the area and I knew that the powers of darkness were operating. Subsequently I asked a team of Sydney intercessors to visit the area and pray, which they did.

Press reports began to expose hidden drug trafficking, and so I requested prayer teams in every State to visit their airports and prayer walk. The reports that came back confirmed that the Lord was

calling us to continue to pray that all hidden corruption would be exposed concerning drug trafficking. Since then teams have visited other entry gates such as local ports.

This is an assignment we can all take up. The rising flood of drugs in to our nation is especially an attack on our youth whose lives are being destroyed by the chains of addiction and death by overdose.

We have also been praying for Schapelle Corby who has claimed that she is innocent of the drug charges made against her. Since her arrest on arrival in Indonesia, it has been revealed that the police are investigating drug trafficking among baggage handlers, and even cabin crews here in Australia. Whilst we are not in a position to claim Schapelle's guilt or innocence, what we do know is that the charges made against her came at a time of drug trafficking through our airports by airline people.

Ephesians 6:12 tells us, *"For our struggle is not against flesh and blood but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms."*

Since her imprisonment Schapelle has, by the grace of God, become a born again Christian. She attends several chapel services a week and is trusting God for her future.

Let's continue to pray that God will expose every hidden plan of the spiritual forces of evil in drug trafficking in our nation.

## **Duyfken visit**

In our previous newsletter I shared on how the Christian Dutch sea captain William Janszoon landed his vessel the "Duyfken" on the shores of Cape York Peninsula four hundred years ago, making him the first European to visit Australia.

To celebrate this event a replica of the Duyfken (the name means 'little dove' – a symbol of the Holy Spirit) is sailing around Australia, and will be in Victor Harbor May 30-June 5.

As I also reported, May 14 marks the four hundred year anniversary of the Portuguese explorer Pedro Fernandez de Quiros's prophetic declaration in Vanuatu that the lands to the south (New Zealand, Australia and the South Pacific) were the South Land of the Holy Spirit.

A team of us from House of Prayer will be in Vanuatu on May 14 to join others in rededicating our region to the Lordship of Christ.

What days we live in as God's prophetic time clock ticks on!

## **Prayer Tower**

With the closing down of the legal firm who so wonderfully allowed us the use of their room as our prayer tower in the city, we wondered if our season of praying in the city was finished. A new legal firm, however, has offered us a room in the same building but on the western side. So having prayed for five years facing the east and the Adelaide Hills, we are now looking over the western plains and the sea. This is spiritually significant as we continue to intercede for the CBD, Adelaide, and the nations. Praise God for the faith of men in the market place who are prepared to sacrifice for the prayer movement.

## **From the Aid Administrator**

Praise the Lord for His faithfulness, and yours too. We thank all who gave financially to Mission World Aid and helped us send all the containers we had packed last year. Every shipping container we sent off, including those to Tanzania, Indonesia, and India, arrived safely and their contents are blessing the recipients.

The forty footer sent to the Watsons, members of the Salvation Army in Mbeya Tanzania, arrived the day before they were due to come back to Australia on furlough so they were able to oversee its unloading and organize some distribution before they left.

Indonesia's container of hospital and dental equipment (plus a large consignment of Australian paint obtained from Topline Paint Pty Ltd) destined for the Christian refugees fleeing from jihad, arrived at the clinic in time for a team of visiting surgeons to utilize some of its contents, and contribute to saving lives. The following is an excerpt from an email sent from Halmahera:

*"The contents of the container have been unpacked and the gear is wonderful. We are already using the dentist's chair and the overhead lamps, desk, examination bed, wheelchair etc etc.*

*We currently have a visiting team performing surgeries both here and at the hospital in town. The equipment sent is already helping save lives. Thank you so much for all you and your wonderful team have done to make this container happen.*

India's container of fifteen tonnes of books, destined for several orphanage schools run by the New India Church of God, was successfully negotiated through customs in Delhi for which we rejoice in the Lord.

The forty footer we packed for the orphanage at Kayunga in Uganda, is awaiting finishing touches to a better method of delivery which is being worked out by our agent. We expect to send it off very soon.

Now we are turning our attention to sending to the South Sea Evangelical Church in the Solomon Islands, the Joseph Project in Israel, and another hospital in Negros Occidental in the Philippines. We have more than enough to fill these three, with others in the pipeline. It looks as if we are in for another busy year! Praise the Lord.

We received this letter of thanks from the Joseph Project in Israel regarding our last container to them.

*“Mission World Aid in Australia recently sent us a wonderful container which included clothing identical to the Israeli Police uniforms. Since it is against the law for regular citizens to wear police uniforms, we donated 27 cartons of new police jackets, shirts, dark blue pants, safety glasses and equipment, and reflective clothing to various branches of the Police Department. Also were added new steel-capped protective shoes. One police chief gratefully met us to receive the large donation and explained the need for these items. Some of the uniforms were needed for trained civil volunteers that the department depends upon, but who did not have uniforms. These specially trained volunteers carry the authority of badged policemen when on volunteer duty. The steel capped shoes will protect the police in various situations, including from becoming injured when in pursuit of those hiding at the construction sites. There have been injuries which these shoes would have prevented.*

*These protective shoes are also being donated to the police departments along the green line and other police departments that need them throughout the country via our Messianic aid centres in the area. This also gives our Messianic centres the chance to meet their local police chiefs personally and to build up the Israeli security situation. Many of the protective shoes are also being given to labour workers living below the poverty line who have been working without protective shoes due to lack of funds. We are grateful to Mission World Aid for this tremendous gift.”*
